



CALL FOR TECHNICAL POSTERS

Speaker slots in the SEG 2010 Technical Session are full and at this time you can view the Technical Program, pre- and post-conference Workshops and Field Trips, and other details at www.seg2010.org.

We are now calling for the submission of Technical Posters via an online submission system at <http://seg.omnicms.com/seg/2010/collection.cgi>. Please visit this site to view instructions for the submission of a short descriptive paragraph, an extended abstract, and your poster. The descriptive paragraph will appear in the printed Conference Program, whereas the poster and abstract will be included on a CD-ROM of Conference Proceedings. All Conference attendees will receive both the CD-ROM and the Conference Program.

As for the oral session, we ask that poster submissions be appropriate to the theme of **The Challenge of Finding New Mineral Resources** that will highlight key commodities in the context of global metallogeny, innovative exploration and new discoveries. Specifically, the conference will focus on **six main commodities** (gold, silver, copper-moly, zinc, nickel-PGE, and uranium), although other commodities of high current interest may be added.

Each commodity will be subdivided into **four topics** :

- revised metallogenic models
- premier metallogenic belt updates
- current exploration methodologies
- recent major discoveries that have not been reported previously

Poster submissions are invited in these six major commodity areas as well as others, among which iron ore, beach sands, rare earths, phosphate, and potash would be particularly pertinent. If your commodity does not fit in the above list, please contact Thomas Monecke at tmonecke@mines.edu.

The poster session will form a key part of the conference and, together with the International Student Conference, the gathering at Keystone promises to be a seminal event in the field of economic geology.
